When: Saturdays 09.00-12.30 school term time.

Where: Ormiston Bushfield Academy, PE2 5RQ



PCYM: MUSIC STARTS HERE

Who: Children ages 5-7 years

Cost: £5.00 per week (1hr)

What: Classes encourage children to explore the joy of making music. Through learning Ukulele or Recorder they will acquire simple skills and the fine muscle control necessary to develop technical proficiency on an instrument. Singing, rhythm and movement teach an instinctive connection between what these young musicians do with their hands, voices, eyes, ears and intellect. This sense of connection is the crucial foundation for learning music.



PCYM: BEGINNERS

Who: Any young musician aged 7-18 wanting to learn an instrument but unable to have lessons at school or privately.

Cost: £31 per week (4hr)

What: Similar to PCYM Core with additional weekly instrumental lesson and a keyboard skills ensemble session whilst they develop the necessary skills for an ensemble on their own instrument.



PCYM: CORE

Who: Any young musician aged 7-18 who is learning an instrument, from beginner right up to grade 8/diploma standard.

Cost: £15 per week (3 ½hr)

What: The majority of young musicians at PCYM take part in our Core Curriculum. It includes an ensemble session on their instrument, a singing session, a musicianship class and weekly student performances. Sessions are grouped according to musical ability and aim to challenge young musicians to maximise their development. Students take part in a series of performances, competitions, workshops and trips throughout the year.

PCYM has junior and senior ensembles across a range of instruments and always looks to expand and enhance the provision to meet the needs and interests of our young musicians.

Substantial bursaries and free instrument loans are available. Please ask for details.
